## OSHA RECORDABLE INJURY DECISION TREE

## OSHA 1904.7(a) dictates whether you need to record an injury.

There are six distinct incidents named in the standard that require an OSHA 301 form. If you're unsure whether an injury (or illness) is recordable, work through this decision tree. If you reach the bottom of the tree, then the injury isn't recordable.



Any injury that resulted in a "Yes" requires a 301 form and ultimately appears on your OSHA 300 log.
